Recommendation:

(1) That funding from the Grant Aid Scheme for 2007/08 totalling £5,000 be awarded to Waltham Abbey Community Association.

Background:

1. Applications for grant aid funding are normally considered and determined by the Portfolio Holder for Community Wellbeing. However, in this instance the Portfolio Holder, being a Waltham Abbey Town Councillor, an occasional volunteer worker for the applicant group and a resident of the locality, has referred the application on to Cabinet, for determination. Accordingly, the Leader and not the Portfolio Holder will report on this item.

Statement in Support of Recommended Action:

2. The application from Waltham Abbey Community Association for funding, as set out in Appendix 1, was deemed worthy under the terms of the Grant Aid Scheme in the amount stated in Column 3 for the reasons set out in Column 4.

3. Options considered in terms of the grant aid application were for the approval (if so the amount concerned), deferral or refusal of the application. There were no other options for consideration within the Community Wellbeing Portfolio as the only transfer of funds, which is possible, is from the various Voluntary Sector Assistance Budgets.
