LOCAL HIGHWAY PANELS	
Brief Summary	
Local Highways Panels (LHPs) have been set up in all 12 Districts across Essex and are represented by County, Borough, District and Parish Councillors.	
These panels are responsible for making recommendations and setting priorities for Highways schemes in their areas. All recommendations are referred to the Cabinet Member for Highways & Transportation for approval and sign off.	
Panel Members meet predominantly on a quarterly basis, some meet more frequently, to discuss and mutually consider Highways expenditure within their local district or borough boundaries.	
Any scheme request should have demonstrable evidence of local community backing and must have the support of the local Councillor whether that is a County, Borough, District or Parish Councillor. Once sufficient support has been gathered, Councilors will complete a scheme request form and forward onto the Highways Liaison Officer (HLO) via email:	
local.highwaypanels@essex.gov.uk who will arrange for this to be taken through the required validation process and if a deliverable scheme, this is then added to the schemes list for consideration of the panel members.	
The scope of works that can be prioritised by the Local Highways Panels is broad and includes the following service areas:	
 Traffic Management improvements Tackling congestion Safer Roads (including casualty reduction) Public Rights of Way improvements Cycling schemes Passenger Transport improvements Minor improvement schemes
