Reason for decision:

This report sets out the District Council's response to the Chelmsford City Council's Local Plan Pre submission Document (Regulation 19-Publication Draft) January 2018 and Brentwood Borough Council's Draft Local Plan Preferred Site Allocations (Regulation 18). A background note on each plan and the responses are attached as appendices expressing this Council's support of the two plans.

Options considered and rejected:

Not to respond to the Chelmsford City Council's Local Plan Pre Submission Document (Regulation 19- Publication Draft) 2018 or the Brentwood Borough Council's Draft Local Plan Preferred Site Allocations (Regulation 18). However, the District Council would not be discharging its responsibilities under the National Planning Policy Framework.

Resource Implications:

The review of the two planning documents and preparation of the report are from within existing resources available to the Planning Policy Team.

Legal and Governance Implications:

The National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) states that "Public bodies have a duty to cooperate on planning issues that cross administrative boundaries, particularly those which relate to the strategic priorities..." and, furthermore, "The Government expects joint working on areas of common interest to be diligently undertaken for the mutual benefit of neighbouring authorities" (para 178). It also expects local authorities "...to demonstrate evidence of having effectively co-operated to plan for issues with cross-boundary impacts when their Local Plans are submitted for Independent Examination. This could be by way of plans or policies prepared as part of a joint committee, a memorandum of understanding or a jointly prepared strategy which is presented as evidence of an agreed position. Cooperation should be a continuous process of engagement from initial thinking through to implementation, resulting in a final position where plans are in place to provide the land and infrastructure necessary to support current and projected future levels of development" (para 181).

Epping Forest District Council works with Chelmsford City Council and Brentwood Borough Council through the mechanism of the West Essex and East Herts Cooperation for Sustainable Development Board. Responding positively to the Plans is a positive way of ensuring ongoing joint and coordinated working with neighbouring authorities.
