Summary of issues to be scrutinised:

Air pollution caused by vehicle emissions.

1. To identify the locations of poor air quality in the district caused by vehicle emissions.
2. To learn how air quality is measured.
3. To consider the penalties available to the district council to address the problem, and the resources available.
4. To make recommendations.
