# Report to Local Highway Panel Programme 2009/10

### **Epping Forest District**

22 September 2009

West Essex Area Office Environment, Sustainability and Highways

#### 1. Purpose of report

- To provide Members with a report on Highway issues within Epping Forest District.
- To provide sufficient information on schemes so that decisions on local priorities can be made.
- Members are invited to offer suggestions and requests for future works.

#### 2. Background

This is the second meeting of the Local Highway Panel, Epping Forest District. We are currently mid-way through the financial year and as such we have completed a large majority of the schemes. The Capital budget is at this stage fully committed. Some schemes completed so far have seen some initial savings. Savings identified later in the year on any projects scheduled, will be reported to the Panel.

#### 3. Programme of Works 2009/2010

#### 3.1. Maintenance

The current programme of Highway Maintenance Initiative schemes are shown in **Appendix A.** 

#### 3.2. Improvements

The current programme of Highway Improvements schemes are shown in **Appendix A**.

#### 3.2.1 Traffic Management Improvements

**Nazeing -** This scheme has a current budget of £85,000 and is likely to incorporate a number of applications to resolve an ongoing issue with regards to HGV traffic. Currently speed assessments are being carried out with a view to change the existing derestricted and reviews are currently being carried out on the signage and permit scheme.

Consideration may be given to amending the existing weight restriction and associated permit scheme. Consultation on the proposals will be carried out shortly. The signs and speed limit restriction are anticipated to be implemented within 2009/10 budget.

#### 3.2.2 Uncontrolled Crossing Improvements

This allocation is for small budget improvement works to uncontrolled crossing points in the District. It includes for example, the provision of dropped (pram) kerbs at well known informal crossing points or provision of tactile paving facilities at uncontrolled crossing points to assist the blind and partially sighted.

Works to Highwood Lane, Oakwood Hill Estate were completed in May and works to the following four junctions are planned to be carried out shortly at Buckhurst Way, Buckhurst Hill: Walnut Way, Holly Close, Willow Close and Birch Close.

#### 3.2.3 Safer Roads Programme

#### **Collision Site Remedial Works**

Currently all schemes have had designs completed, safety audits are commencing and agreement of estimates are being sought.

#### **Area Identified Safety Schemes**

**Pudding Lane, Chigwell -** Informal consultation documents have been issued this week to all concerned stakeholders. If agreement is gained, the formal consultation process is envisaged to commence early to mid October. This includes factoring in the legal process of drafting and approving the order for publication in the press. The statutory 21 day consultation process will take us into November.

With regards to the build-outs, the speed limit must be installed first and is dependant on the consultation period and any objections received. Taking account of the above timing, the signing works are provisionally scheduled to commence late November, with the build-out works to follow, hopefully before Christmas.

#### 3.2.4 Public Rights of Way Improvements

The current programme of Public Rights of Way schemes are shown in Appendix A.

**Byway 21, Fyfield** – We are experiencing some technical difficult with regards to a retaining wall over a culvert at this location. We are liaising with our partners to further this scheme.

#### 3.2.5 Passenger Transport Improvements

#### **Quality Bus Partnership Improvements**

Design work has commenced and is due to be issued to the contractor at the end of September 2009 for estimating.

#### **Bus Passenger Shelter**

We are currently working with Passenger Transport to further these projects.

#### **Safer Journeys**

We are liaising with the local schools to development these schemes.

### 4. Community Initiative Fund

Essex County Council wishes to provide support for communities throughout Essex to deliver highways improvements that matter to local residents. A total of £1million is available across the County for community enhancing schemes.

Nine projects were approved in 2008/09 and are currently being carried out. These are detailed within **Appendix A**. These schemes are advancing well. We liaise continually with the applicants at each stage of the process.

Applications can be made by any constituted body, such as Town or Parish Councils, Residents Associations or Community Organisations. Panel Members may wish to advise any appropriate body that wishes to take advantage of this opportunity.

The projects should take account of ECC and Essex Partnership priorities, which include tackling crime and anti-social behaviour, improving local environment features, access to services and supporting communities. Eligible projects could include: new footways, cycling and horse riding facilities, bus stop hard standings, and junction and pedestrian crossing improvements. The maximum amount per individual bid is £50,000.

Application forms and guidance notes can be obtained from the website:

www.communityinitiativesfund.co.uk. Once submitted to the Area Highway Manger by 6th November 09, the application will go through an assessment process and a judging panel, consisting of representatives from Town and Parish Councils, and community and voluntary organisations, will allocate funding to successful bids during April and March 2010. Successful applications will be delivered by the Area Highway Manager in line with priorities and agreed programme within the 2010/2011 budget.

#### 5. Localism Revenue Budget

The Localism revenue schemes address a number of highway problems and incorporate a wide variety of measures including parking and speed restrictions, improvements or introduction of pedestrian crossing facilities and other traffic management improvements.

Current projects are detailed in **Appendix A.** Speed assessments, safety audits and consultations are being carried out.

#### 6. Area Parking Review

**Buckhurst Hill** - Consultation documents have been sent out to the residents of Buckhurst Hill and information evenings have been organised for 7th, 9th, 15th and 17th September 09.

**Epping** – Analysis of the response is been carried out prior to recommendations being presented to EFDC.

**Loughton Broadway** – Consultation documents have almost been completed, for a final draft to be submitted to Epping Forest District Council in October 2009.

#### 7. Developer Funded Schemes

Ongar, train station, Section 278 works - It is anticipated that the works for the construction of this bellmouth shall start imminently.

Ongar, Former ECC Highways Depot – Works are being undertaken to obtain highway rights on the land required to implement a crossing. Should this fail, alternatives will need to be sought.

#### 8. Highway Maintenance Revenue Budget

Details of works completed by the Reactive Accelerated Maintenance Initiative (RAMI) gang are detailed in **Appendix B.** 

#### 8.1. Highway Rangers

Works recently completed by the Rangers and proposed for the current month are detailed in **Appendix C.** 

Suggestions for future works are welcomed by Members.

### 9. Epping Forest Transport Strategy

Essex County Council is working in partnership with the City of London Corporation and the surrounding London Boroughs of Epping Forest, in developing and achieving the Epping Forest Transport Strategy. The aim of this Strategy is to investigate and identify options in order to improve safety and accessibility for Epping Forest users, to reduce adverse environmental impacts on the Forest area, and to assist with the re-establishment of commoners' cattle grazing.

A number of schemes have been identified for implementation by the Highways Department. We aim to execute some of these within the 2009/10 budget programming. Reports shall be presented to the Panel when the details are confirmed.
