We live near this property and I note that this business has applied to extend its opening hours by one hour, meaning that it would remain open until midnight on Sundays to Thursdays and until 2.am on Fridays and Saturdays.

You will know that it is sited on a busy corner which is well used by pedestrians and which carries pedestrian traffic to and from the station, often from late evening trains. Unfortunately, this type of bar attracts a class of customer which can often be noisy, numerous and careless of normal standards of behaviour. The premises are not large and the drinkers have been known to spill out onto the footway, presenting a seemingly threatening crowd to passers-by. Generally, Nu-Bar does not have a good reputation locally because of the type of person it attracts.

The owners understandably want to enlarge their business and make it more successful from their point of view. However, in view of the foregoing, I must object to their application on the following grounds:

- there would be an increased risk of crime and disorder late at night
- · residents should be able come and go without feeling nervous or threatened
- there would be an increased risk of public disturbance and noise.

Sadly, there are already problems of this sort in Loughton, and in society as a whole, and it would be undesirable to add to local problems by allowing this application.

We are writing to object to the application by the Nu-Bar to extend its opening hours by an hour, to closing at midnight on Sunday to Thursday and 2am on Friday and Saturday.

Although in the High Road, The Nu-Bar is in close proximity to private housing; there are flats in both Old Station Road and the High Road, and flats and houses in Ollards Grove, Connaught Avenue, Connaught Hill, High Beech Road and Smarts Lane. We are already experiencing noise nuisance, particularly when customers leave the bar late at night, shouting and yelling.

Any extension to licensing hours would undoubtedly exacerbate the noise problem and increase the incidence of crime and disorder with neighbouring cars being damaged and residents gardens vandalised etc. Broken glass, bottles and vomit are often found in the streets.



I was shocked and saddened to learn that consideration is being given to an application by the owner of Nu-Bar for an extension to their opening hours.

As a resident of Ollards Grove I have been forced, since the opening of this bar, to endure constant excruciatingly loud music from the bar, regular late night fights and shouting outside my residence, noise from customers leaving the bar in their cars that they park in Ollards Grove (these cars regularly block the whole road and the entrance to my residence), and most recently late night noise from customers of the bar who appear to be drug dealing in the garage forecourts opposite my residence.



I would wish to strongly object to the application by The Nu Bar to extend their opening times by one hour, for the following reasons, and because these premises are at the bottom of our road, and many of the roads that are affected by the operation of these premises are residential.
