



The Sub-Committee received a report from the licensing compliance officer, D Houghton, who detailed the incident that had been report by the license holder, and the potential implication in relation to the license.

Members of the Sub-Committee considered the report and information given by the Licensing Compliance Officer.

The Chairman read out a statement of the Sub-Committee's decision, and detailed that the applicant had the right to appeal the decision in a Magistrate's Court within 21 days of the decision.

**Decision:**

That a formal written warning would be sent to the license holder and that the license would be suspended for a four-month period.
