25. APPLICATION FOR A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE - MR L RAHMAN

Members noted that officers did not have delegated powers to grant this application and, as a result, the application had to be considered by the Sub-Committee.

The Chairman welcomed the applicant and introduced the Members and officers present. The Licensing Officer informed the Sub-Committee of the circumstances by which the licence could not be issued under delegated authority.

The applicant made a short statement in support of his application, before answering a number of questions from Members of the Sub-Committee. The applicant then made a short closing statement to the Sub-Committee before the Chairman requested that the applicant leave the Chamber whilst the Sub-Committee debated the application in private. The Members received advice from the Legal Officer present regarding Sections 2 and 3 of the Licensing Policy, which related to discretion in considering previous convictions. The Chairman invited the applicant back into the Chamber and informed him f the Sub-Committee's decision.
