For the purposes of street trading, all streets within the District have been designated consent streets, which means that anyone wishing to trade must obtain a consent from the Council.

An application for such a consent, attached, has been received.

Following consultation with Members, Officers, the Highways Authority, the Police and the publication of a notice of intention by in the local newspaper, objections to the application were received from Waltham Abbey Town Council and one local trader.
