**2. Presentation by Emma Jackson – Essex Police**

It was suggested that when things happen that directly affect young people, then press releases should reflect the ages of whom they want to reach, to be reader friendly. Emma took the point and agreed to discuss with her colleagues.

Sonny talked about the need for more support for families that experienced a serious crime or incident, he proposed that the Youth Council make a new film as part of the 'We R Safe' films, that the previous Youth Council produced in 2018. The 6<sup>th</sup> We R Safe film would be called 'Ripples' to address how the incident affects other people. The ripple effects. There would be 3 elements in the film: Police, Paramedic and an Ex-Offender. The Youth Councillors and Emma all thought it was a great idea.

Emma thanked the Youth Council for inviting her to attend the meeting.
