1. STANDARDS COMMITTEE - ANNUAL REPORT 2004/05

Recommending:

(1) To receive the third annual report of the Standards Committee attached as Annex 1; and

(2) To adopt the protocol on gifts and hospitality attached as Annex 2.

- 1.1 The third annual report of the Epping Forest District Standards Committee is attached as Annex 1.
 - 1.2 The aim of the report is to describe some of the issues which have arisen since the last report of the Committee and future developments.
 - 1.3 The main activities of the Committee have related to:
 - (a) codes of conduct issues;

(b) the framework for adjudicating/investigating allegations against elected members;

- (c) general advice on ethical issues;
- (d) registration of members' interests;
- (e) registration of gifts and hospitality; and
- (f) allegations about individual councillors dealt with by the Standards Board.
- 1.4 We are also recommending adoption of a protocol on acceptance of gifts and hospitality. This is designed to support the duty of elected and co-opted Councillors under the Codes of Conduct to record gifts and hospitality of a value in excess of £25. The protocol sets out some definitions and guidance on what can be accepted and where caution may be necessary.
- 1.5 We recommend as set out in the commencement of this report.
