1. The Strategic Assessment is produced by the Community Safety Partnership every year, and it sets out the priorities for the forthcoming year. These priorities are based upon the previous year's performance and current data led intelligence. It is prepared by the Partnerships Strategic Analyst using data from a range of accredited sources.
