Recommendations:

That, in order to enable the replacement of the atrium ventilators, a supplementary DDF estimate in the sum of £15,000 be recommended to the Council for approval.

Report:

- 1. An integral part of the fire management strategy for the atrium area of the civic office complex is, in the event of a fire condition, having the ability to automatically ventilate the products of combustion via the opening of pneumatic ventilators located at the head of the atrium.
- 2. Following the failure of a number of the ventilators and the subsequent inspection by a specialist contractor, it has been established that due to the age of the ventilators it is no longer possible to procure replacement parts.
- 3. To address the defect, it is proposed to install eight louvred ventilators complete with pneumatic cylinders at a cost of approximately £15,000.

4. It is essential that this unacceptable situation be rectified with the utmost expediency.
