Impact on the social, economic and environmental well-being of the area:
There is a big impact on the area because of this issue. It means that if communal areas of flat blocks are not kept up to a modern standard, residents of these blocks cannot take pride in this shared part of their home, and the visual appearance of these communal parts is of no asset to the area in which they are situated.
Sometimes the need for improvement extends to external areas; in the case of the large flat blocks referred to, the outside porches / entrances to the communal area are also neglected and visually detrimental to the area.
If one feature in the communal area of a flat block is not improved, it is a concern, but if 2 or more features deteriorate and no improvements are made, then the building may contrast unfavourably with other dwellings in the area.
