Recommendation:

That Tree Preservation Order 18/13 is not confirmed.

Background

- 1. A pre application indicative scheme for a new residential development on the site showed a loss of trees on the site. This threat resulted in TPO/EPF/18/13 being served in July 2013, provisionally giving protection to selected trees across the site.
- 2. An objection was made in respect of certain individual and groups of trees, which resulted in a review of the original order and the service of a new order: TPO/EPF/03/14. This new order focusses protection on higher value trees.

The Director of Planning and Economic Development comments as follows:

- 3. The discussed scheme for a new housing development would have resulted in an unacceptable loss of dominant landscape features. This justified the service of the original provisional order TPO/EPF/18/13.
- 4. Detailed discussions about this order took place and it was agreed that a number of screening groups of trees and selected individuals might be removed from a new order: TPO/EPF/03/14. This new order has been served and is effective.
- 5. Any new planning application will need to give full design consideration these high value trees.
