Loughton Town Council	Section 5, paragraph 5,4 th line be amended to read “Parish or Town Council”.	Agreed
Association of British Bookmakers	That the following be inserted into the statement of principles: “...there is no evidence that the operation of betting offices has required door supervisors for the protection of the public. The authority will make a door supervision requirement only if there is clear evidence from the history of trading at the premises that the premises cannot be adequately supervised from the counter and that door supervision is both necessary and proportionate”.	The Licensing Committee have rejected this request
Association of British Bookmakers	That the following be inserted into the statement of principles: “While the authority has discretion as to the number, nature and circumstances of use of betting machines, there is no evidence that such machines give rise to regulatory concerns. This authority will consider limiting the number of machines only where there is clear evidence that such machines have been or are likely to be used in breach of licensing objectives. Where there is such evidence, this authority may consider, when reviewing the licence, the ability of staff to monitor the use of such machines from the counter”	The Licensing Committee have rejected this request
Association of British Bookmakers	That the following be inserted into the statement of principles: “The authority recognises that certain bookmakers have a number of premises within its area. In order to ensure that any compliance issues are recognised and resolved at the earliest stage, operators are requested to give that authority a single named point of contact, who should be a senior individual, and whom the authority will contact first should any compliance queries or issues arise”	The Licensing Committee have agreed to insert the following “The authority recognises that certain bookmakers have a number of premises within its area.
