Subject: Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Conditions and Guidance

Decisions Required:

(1) To recommend to Council that the new Public Hire conditions/guidance be adopted.

Report:

1. At the meeting of this committee on 8 April 2015 members considered a report which outlined the current state of the council's public hire licensing conditions and guidance. It was decided that an in depth revision should be undertaken and a member/officer sub-group was set up to consider if the conditions/guidance were fit for purpose and what (if any) changes should be made.

2. The sub-group considered a number of issues including:

- the licensing of MPV's;
- the licensing of vehicles for less than four passengers;
- advertising on vehicles;
- guidance on how to deal with infringements of the conditions; and
- any other updating measures thought necessary paying particular reference to safeguarding.

3. Subsequently the conditions/guidance was amended and a full consultation with the trade and other interested parties undertaken. The consultation returns together with officer responses are attached at Appendix 1.

4. Copies of the proposed conditions/guidance are attached at Appendix 2.

Resource Implications:

There may be a need for increased enforcement activity however this can be undertaken within existing resources.
