
You will know that it is sited on a busy corner which is well used by pedestrians and which carries pedestrian traffic to and from the station, often from late evening trains. Unfortunately, this type of bar attracts a class of customer which can often be noisy, numerous and careless of normal standards of behaviour. The premises are not large and the drinkers have been known to spill out onto the footway, presenting a seemingly threatening crowd to passers-by. Generally, Nu-Bar does not have a good reputation locally because of the type of person it attracts.

The owners understandably want to enlarge their business and make it more successful from their point of view. However, in view of the foregoing, I must object to their application on the following grounds:

- there would be an increased risk of crime and disorder late at night

We are writing to object to the application by the Nu-Bar to extend its opening hours by an hour, to closing at midnight on Sunday to Thursday and 2am on Friday and Saturday.

Although in the High Road, The Nu-Bar is in close proximity to private housing; there are flats in both Old Station Road and the High Road, and flats and houses in Ollards Grove, Connaught Avenue, Connaught Hill, High Beech Road and Smarts Lane. We are already experiencing noise nuisance, particularly when customers leave the bar late at night, shouting and yelling.

Any extension to licensing hours would undoubtedly exacerbate the noise problem and increase the incidence of crime and disorder with neighbouring cars being damaged and residents gardens vandalised etc. Broken glass, bottles and vomit are often found in the streets.

Public safety is also threatened as the Nu-Bar is on the pedestrian route from Loughton Station and people are intimidated when trying to walk home past the crowd of hyped-up, drunk and disorderly people who mass around the premises.

We strongly object to this application for extension of opening hours and hope these comments will be taken into account when deciding upon the application.

As a nearby resident (I live in High Beech Road), I would like to strongly object to the application made by the Nu-Bar to extend their opening hours by an hour (closing midnight Sunday to Thursday and 2.00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday).

At présent the noise from the people frequenting the numerous bars in the area is unbearable, not only during the weekend but also during the week. I think the only peaceful night we get is on a Monday when two of the bars are closed (including the Nu-Bar). The shouting, screaming and screeching of tyres from users of these bars leaving the area is atrocious. They have no respect for nearby residents and the problem will only get worse if the licence is granted.

To reiterate I would like to strongly object on the following grounds

:

- Late night disorder and noise from users of the establishment (including the racing of cars)

I do not ever hear any music emanting from the premises or have any problems with any customers parking near to my property .

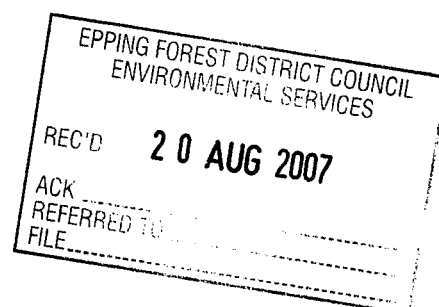
The bar is known locally now as a bar which is safe to drink in and which caters for ages from 21 to 61 , this definately isn't one of the bars which has youngsters drinking


It is a favourite , as is my restaurant, of Premiership footballers and TV stars alike , telling you that this is not a place that has a ' low-life ' clientele.

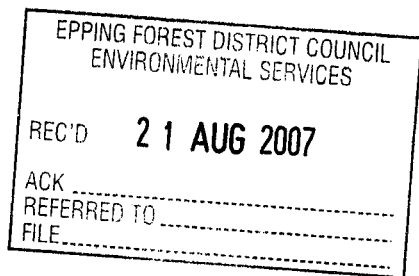
