



As a nearby resident, I write to strongly object to the application by Nu-Bar to the District Council to extend their opening hours by an hour, closing at midnight Sunday to Thursday and 2am on Friday and Saturday. It attracts a large crowd of younger people, rather than traditional pub customers. I object to the extension of hours on the grounds of:


- the prevention of crime and disorder late at night;


