**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDERS 2019  
FOOTPATHS 29 AND 33 EPPING**

The above orders made on 19 July 2019 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, as shown on the order maps will divert:

1) Footpath 29 commencing from a point located west of the unnamed highway south of Stewards Green Road opposite the property known as Bridge Barn running in a south westerly then a south south westerly direction across a field for 317 metres to the point where the footpath enters a garden where it continues in a generally westerly direction through the garden of a private dwelling for a final distance of 242 metres to where it connects to Footpath 28 Epping, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing from a point located west of the unnamed highway south of Stewards Green Road approximately 92 metres north of the existing start point running in a generally west then west south westerly then south westerly direction along the field edge a minimum of 2 metres south of the stream for a distance of approximately 204 metres to the point where it crosses a drainage ditch before continuing in first a generally northerly then generally westerly direction along the field edge maintaining a distance of at least 2 metres south of the stream for a final distance of 366 metres to the point where it connects to Footpath 28 Epping.

2) A part length of Footpath 33 commencing from a point located at the pathway running behind the properties of Albany Court running in a north westerly direction through property boundaries for a total distance of 54 metres to the point where it connects to the public highway known as Albany Court, to an alternative route being of variable width being boundary to boundary shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned start point running in a north easterly direction along an existing pathway for a total distance of 31 metres to where it connects to the public highway known as Albany Court being 54 metres south east of its existing connection to that highway.

## **PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2019 FOOTPATH 10 EPPING**

The above order, made on 19 July 2019, under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish a part length of Footpath 10 Epping of unknown width commencing from the point where it meets the public highway known as Centre Drive running in a north north westerly then north westerly direction across numerous property boundaries and gardens for a total distance of approximately 263 metres to a point opposite Pelly Court where it continues unaffected.

A copy of the Orders and the Order maps have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Epping Forest District Council, Civic Offices, 323 High Street, Epping, Essex CM16 4BZ and at Chelmsford Public Library, Market Road CM1 1QH during normal working hours. Copies are available on request from the Chelmsford Library at a charge.

Any representations about or objections to the orders may be sent in writing to Robert Lee, Definitive Map Service, Essex County Council, Seax House, 2nd Floor, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford CM1 1QH not later than 5 September 2019. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the Orders as unopposed orders. If the Orders are sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Orders. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
