
This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Epping Forest District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated south of Stewards Green Road known as Footpath 29 Epping in the District of Epping Forest and shown by a bold continuous line on the order map numbered PROW-19-11 rev.20.06.19 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated south of Stewards Green Road known as Footpath 29 Epping in the District of Epping Forest described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the order map numbered PROW-19-11 rev.20.06.19 contained in this order.



SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The entire length of Footpath 29 Epping of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 54736,20087 located west of the unnamed highway south of Stewards Green Road opposite the property known as Bridge Barn running in a south westerly then a south south westerly direction across a field for an approximate distance of 317 metres to point **B** at grid reference 54715,20065 where it continues in a generally westerly direction through to the garden of a private dwelling for a final distance of approximately 242 metres to point **C** at grid reference 54691, 20062 where it connects to Footpath 28 Epping.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at point **D** at grid reference 54737,20097 located west of the unnamed highway south of Stewards Green Road approximately 92 metres north of the existing start point running in a generally west then west south westerly then south westerly direction along the field edge a minimum of 2 metres south of the stream for a distance of approximately 204 metres to point **E** at grid reference 54717,20092 where it crosses a drainage ditch before continuing in first a generally northerly then generally westerly direction along the field edge maintaining a distance of at least 2 metres south of the stream for a final distance of approximately 366 metres to point **F** at grid reference 54687,20098 where it connects to Footpath 28 Epping.
