In total, 15 Housing Service Strategies have been produced to date, covering:

 - Rent Arrears;
 - Rent Collection and Administration;
 - Homelessness;
 - Under-occupation;
 - Housing Information;
 - Tenant Participation;
 - Private Rented Sector;
 - Housing Management Services;
 - Older Peoples Housing Services;
 - Housing Allocations;
 - Housing Advice;
 - Empty Properties;
 - Energy Efficiency; and
 - Anti-Social Behaviour.
- 2. The Strategies are produced to a common format that set out how individual housing services will be delivered. They have assisted Housing Services in achieving the Charter Mark award for customer service excellence, and ISO 9001:2000 Quality Accreditation.
- 3. At its meeting on 25th October 2007, the Housing Scrutiny Panel considered the updated Housing Service Strategy on Housing Information, and their comments have been incorporated in the documents.
