NOTES ON REGULATED ENTERTAINMENT

In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman
 wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not
 exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or
 wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an
 indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the
 audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains
 licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

LICENSING APPLICATION: The Hive Loughton, 38 Chigwell Lane Loughton Essex IG10 3NY

We object to this application on the basis of the prevention of public nuisance.

The Hive obtained permission for their café in this location to serve the industrial estate during working hours. At the time they stated that they would not wish to compete with the food outlets on The Broadway. We note they have gradually pushed their opening hours allowed by their planning permission later, till 9pm in the week and 6pm on Sundays (EPF/1164/20, granted), although they failed to get to 10pm (EPF/0457/18) which was refused on the grounds that the additional hours will introduce excessive noise and activity in vicinity of the site, which will cause excessive harm to the living conditions of the occupiers of neighbouring dwellings particularly the four dwelling to the north of the site.

We consider 11pm all week and midnight on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve is far too late. Patrons leaving the premises will disturb the occupiers of the four homes and other residents in the vicinity while they make their way home particularly during the summer months when bedroom windows are normally open.

We also suggest the licensing committee inform the applicant of the need for planning permission, that a recent planning application for later hours was refused and alert the planning department's enforcement team.

Notice of Application for a variation of premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of The Hive Cafe, 38b Chigwell Lane, Loughton, Essex, IG10 3NY

The Committee OBJECTED to this application for a variation of the current premises licence on the grounds of

- 1. the prevention of public nuisance; and
- 2. the protection of children from harm.

This is a café (open during the working week) close to residential properties and there are no other retail premises close by. There are already licensed premises in The Broadway to serve this trade. The industrial estate on which it is situated is only open during the usual working day so would be closed at the times requested. Such opening hours would severely affect the quiet enjoyment of the residents of their homes adjacent to the café. Furthermore, it would be a potential cause of harm to local children.
