Dear Miss Elizabeth Cox,

Re application on behalf of CLUB EDGE for reinstating of pole dancing and including Full Nudity to be added to the current licensable activities.

I am in receipt of such an application made by Mr Michael Stock the current Designated Premises Supervisor. The application on page 2 states that such a license was held for this activity in 2001. I have searched our electronic data bases and hard copy files and can find no trace of such a license. I have also checked with the licensing Authority and they are unable to find such a license being granted.

These premises have historically suffered its problems with a range of anti social activity with three major incidents in 2007. These are assaults, drunkenness, and criminal damage, to a window computer and car roof.

If the license for Nude dancing was pemitted, this activity would in all probability attract large numbers of young men and with a capacity for only 224 refused entry at the front door is likely to trigger disturbances or violent behaviour.

I have sought the advice of Senior Police Commanders and with comments I am about to raise Essex Police will be rigorously object to the grant of such a license.

Thus under the licensing objective of The Prevention of Crime and disorder Police object as there is likely to be an increase in crime and disorder. There are already numerous complaints to Police of anti social behaviour in the early hours of Fridays Saturdays and Sunday mornings in the Epping High Street area.

The applicant seeking the license has the premises on the ground floor of the end building in Cottis Lane nearest to Bakers Lane Car Park. The premises immediately above is a night club who also made a similar application in 2006 which went to a full hearing and that application was refused.

The applicant's application for the premises is located close to residential properties and we believe that thisan inappropriate activity to be held near residences.



Upon examining the application form on Page 13 under the heading "Describe any addition steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives as a result of the proposed variation, there five distinct boxes for the applicant to complete under the following headings,

a) General- all four licensing objectives,

b))The prevention of crime and disorder

c) Public Safety

d) The prevention of public nuisance

e) The protection of children from harm.

None of these objectives have been addressed as the whole page is BLANK.

Therefore Essex Police are objecting to this application under the heading of Prevention of Crime and Disorder.


